COSTUME INFORMATION

COSTUMES

Costumes should NOT be worn for any reason except Picture Day, Dress Rehearsal, and Performances. Costumes CANNOT be replaced if lost or damaged. Dancers should wear a cover-up over their costume when waiting to rehearse/perform. We recommend a Bathrobe or oversized button down shirt. Shirts That have to be pulled over the head will not Work as they will mess up hair and make up.

UNDERGARMENTS

We strongly encourage every dancer to wear flesh toned body suits/leos under their costumes if they have costume changes and may not be comfortable getting changed in front of others. Dancers requiring bras must wear nude colored with clear straps. No colorful undergarments may be showing. You can purchase nude colored bras and/or underwear from any dance retailer (we highly recommend NKY Dancewear) or any clothing stores (Target, Walmart etc.)

HAIR ACCESSORIES

If your costume came with a hair accessory, it should be placed on the dancer's right side of the head.

TIGHTS/SHOES

Please make sure your dancer has the correct colored tights and shoes for each dance. You can find this information on their costume checklist located inside of their garment bag.

MAKE UP/HAIR

All dancers must wear make-up on stage. Foundation, blush and lipstick that compliments their skin tone will help make sure they do not look washed out from the lighting on stage.

Girls: foundation, bronzer, blush, mascara, red lipstick, neutral eyeshadow.

Boys: Foundation, bronzer, light blush

PICTURE WEEK

Arrive 5-10 minutes prior to your scheduled time. Be dressed in your first costume with hair and makeup done.

Please put on the appropriate shoes for the first class you are doing the photo for upon arriving. Do not wear dance shoes outside of the studio.

Dancers will take individual and group photos in their recital costumes during their class time slot.

- ★ There will be dressing rooms for dancers who have multiple costumes. If your dancer only has one costume, please arrive in costume and ready to go to avoid the dressing rooms getting overcrowded.
- ★ If your dancer has a solo, duet, or trio and would like photos taken, they may come during any of the time slots labeled **Solos/Duets/Trios**
- ★ Parents and dancers are only allowed in the photography room (studio A) if your class is on deck for photos. Please only one parent per dancer. You may wait in the lobby area or dressing room until your group is called into the photography room.
- ★ With the busy nature of the week, we kindly ask that no extra family members or friends attend. Just the dancer and 1 parent/guardian please.
- ★ Order information will be emailed out before picture week. All ordering is done online. You will not order at the studio during picture week.
- ★ If your dancer is not participating in the recital therefore does not have a costume, he/she is welcome to still have individual photos taken in their dance attire if they wish during solo times. Group photos will only be for those with a costume.

- ★ Please arrive 10 minutes prior to your scheduled time. Be dressed in your first costume, with hair & make up done. Come to the auditorium and wait for your class to be called up on stage.
- ★ all classes will get the chance to run through their routine on stage. We will begin with our finale (everyone in the show) and then run through each show beginning to end. Once your dancer has practiced all of his/her dances on stage, he/she is dismissed.
- ★ All students are expected to wear **full costume** to dress rehearsal. This includes hair and make up.
- ★ All dancers performing in the recital must be in attendance for the dress rehearsal and remain seated in the auditorium until their class is called on stage or dismissed.
- ★ Dancers will check in when they arrive. Please look for the table labeled "DANCER CHECK IN". This is where they can pick up their recital t-shirts.
- ★ Dressing rooms will be available for dancers who have multiple costumes. Please label all of your belongings.
- ★ Please be seated in the auditorium so we can start promptly at 4:00pm. Parents are welcome to stay for dress rehearsal.
- ★ You may take non-flash photos at rehearsals, and you may video ONLY your child's dance(s).

DANCE RECITAL

- ★ Dancers will stay in their designated room until the show is over. This includes during intermission so please make sure they eat before they come.
- ★ **No food will be allowed in the dressing rooms**
- ★ Each show will be approximately 1 hour long
- ★ Dancers must stay in their costume for the finale. If your dancer has more than one costume, they will stay in their last costume.
- ★ There will be designated helping moms and staff members in each room to help get the dancers on and off stage.
- ★ If your dancer has a costume change, parents will be permitted in the dressing room *ONLY* during intermission to assist their dancer. If your dancer requires a costume change before intermission, the helping mom will be able to assist.
- ★ After the finale, all dancers level 2 and below will remain onstage. Once the curtains close, one parent/guardian will be permitted to come backstage to pick up his/her dancer. Levels 3-4 will be dismissed and can be picked up in their dressing room.

DANCER DROP OFF/PICK UP

Parent/Guardian will sign their dancer in at the check in table and then take them back to their designated waiting room. Dancers should be dressed in their first costume with hair and make up done. Dancers must stay in their room for the duration of the show; no early pickups will be allowed unless you have submitted a request IN WRITING and have been approved.

Dancers will not be allowed to leave the dressing areas during intermission for safety reasons. If a dancer needs changed during intermission, it is their parent/guardian's responsibility to get their dancer(s) changed and only during this time. If your dancer needs changed before intermission, their class mom volunteers will help.

After our finale bows (finale with all of the dancers), dancers level 2 and below (creative movement, tiny tumble, pre ballet, mini bop hip hop, level 1) will remain on stage. Once the curtain closes, one parent/guardian listed on their dancers pick up list will be permitted

backstage to pick up their dancer. Dancers level 3-4 can be picked up in their designated room.

T SHIRTS

Dancer's Recital T shirts can be picked up at the check in table when you check your dancer in for dress rehearsal. Order forms will be sent soon for any parent, sibling etc. who would like to purchase a recital t-shirt as well.

TICKETS

- Tickets will go on sale May 1, 2024 at 10:00am.
- Tickets can be purchased by visiting our website.
- Tickets will not be available for purchase at the studio
- Tickets are \$15.00 each. Reserved Seating.
- Anyone needing a seat will need to purchase a ticket.
- Dancers and parent volunteers *do not* need a ticket.
- Reminder: Every family registered for recital will receive one free ticket code via email before May 1.
- Tickets will be scanned upon arrival.
- Please purchase your tickets prior to arriving. Tickets will only be sold online, not at the door.

PACKING LIST

- All costumes, shoes, tights, undergarments, accessories, make up.

- Closeable water bottle with your name on it.
 - Hair spray, bobby pins, hair elastics etc.
 - Quiet, clean activities to keep occupied if you'd like-this is not required. We will also provide items such as coloring/reading books (no markers), cards, activity books etc.
- *Lost/stolen items are not the responsibility of Prestige Dance Center

- Food- NO FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS
- Any liquids other than water in a closeable bottle
- Expensive electronics
- Any jewelry (other than the approved jewelry for competition teams)

FAQ's

What is a Dance Recital?

A dance recital is your dancers' time to "shine" on stage and show off everything they have learned in class by performing for their family members and friends.

When/ Where is the Recital?

The recital is on Saturday, June 1, at Turpin High School.. Show times are 2:00pm and 4:00pm.

When/Where is Dress Rehearsal?

Dress Rehearsal is Friday, May 31 at Turpin High School.

WHAT DOES MY CHILD WEAR TO DRESS REHEARSAL?

Full costume is mandatory for dress rehearsal. Make up and hair is required.

CAN THE TEACHERS DO MY CHILD'S HAIR AND MAKE UP?

Please bring your child with their costume on and their hair and makeup already done. Neither the teachers nor the volunteer parents will have time to prep your child for the stage. If you are unable to do your child's hair or make up, please let their teacher know immediately and we will make sure you and your child receive help.

CAN I GO BACKSTAGE WITH MY CHILD?

Only teachers, PDC Staff, and helping parent volunteers may be backstage with their dancers. They will keep the kids entertained, and monitor potty trips for ALL of the children backstage, not just their own dancer.

CAN WE LEAVE THE RECITAL AFTER MY CHILD HAS FINISHED DANCING?

All dancers are required to stay for the entire show, as they will walk out for the finale bow. There will be volunteers and PDC staff who will make sure your dancer is taken backstage before their performance and back to their correct room after their performance so you can enjoy the show from the audience.

CAN I TAKE PICTURES AND/OR VIDEO OF MY CHILD ON STAGE?

For the safety of your dancers, there will be no flash photography or videotaping permitted inside the theater. A professional videographer will be taping the entire show. Recital videos are wonderful keepsakes for years to come, and are included in your recital fee!

WHERE DO I PICK MY CHILD UP AFTER THE SHOW?

After the show, Creative Movement, PreBallet/Tap, Tiny Tumble, Mini Bop Hip Hop, Level 1 and Level 2 dancers will remain on stage immediately following the finale and parents will be able to pick them up from there. Level 3 and up can arrange with their parent/guardian to meet somewhere in the lobby or right outside of the theater.

HOW DO I GET TICKETS TO THE SHOW?

Tickets will go on sale for \$15.00 May 1 .

DO I NEED A RECITAL TICKET FOR MY DANCER?

No, dancers do not need a recital ticket since they will not be seated in the auditorium.

HOW LONG IS THE SHOW?

Each show will run approximately 1 hour.

IS THERE AN INTERMISSION?

There will be a 15 min intermission during both shows.

WILL THERE BE CONCESSIONS?

There will be concessions sold during intermission. No food or drink is permitted in the auditorium, but there will be a lobby for you to enjoy your refreshments.

WILL FLOWERS BE FOR SALE?

We will have a flower pre-sale online again this year! Flowers will also be sold before the show and during intermission. The tradition of giving flowers after a dance recital is centuries old, and it's a great way to let your performer know he/she did an exceptional job. Please refrain from bringing store bought flowers.

WILL THERE BE RECITAL T SHIRTS FOR SALE?

Recital T shirts are also included in your recital fee! Recital T shirts are a great keepsake for dancers and fun to collect over the years! Parents, siblings, fans etc. will also have the chance to purchase a recital t shirt if they'd like!

In days when musicals began at 8:30pm, this song would usually appear around 11:00pm, hence the 11 O’Clock Number!
